There are 6 observed holidays: 1. Independence Day, 2. Labor Day, 3. Thanksgiving Day, 4. Christmas Day, 5. New Year's Day, and 6. Memorial Day. Collection days, highlighted above in yellow, will be delayed by one day.

- Trash collection occurs weekly on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays.

- Recycling collection occurs bi-weekly on the same day as your trash collection.
- Households have been divided into alternating weekly recycling collection groups A and B. Dates are highlighted above in **green**.

- Bulk items will be collected twice a year. Dates are highlighted above in **red**.
- White goods will be collected twice a year. Dates are highlighted above in **blue**.
- Register for curbside pickup of your bulk item or white good at bit.ly/topsfieldtrash

- There will be two opportunities to dispose of old trash and recycling containers. Dates are highlighted above in **orange**. Visit bit.ly/topsfieldtrash for more information.

RECYCLING BEYOND CURBSIDE COLLECTION

Leaves and Yard Waste

- Bring to the Topsfield Public Works compost facility at 279 Boston St., Saturdays from 9am-1pm between April-November. Topsfield/Boxford residents only. Season pass required.

Extra Cardboard

- Bring to the Topsfield Public Works cardboard-only dumpster at 279 Boston St., during operating hours. Topsfield residents only.

Extra Recycling & Bulk Items

- Bring to the Boxford Recycling Center at 7B Spofford Rd. (behind the DPW Garage), Saturdays only from 8am-3:30pm. Fees apply. (www.boxfordma.gov/399/Recycling-Center-Information)
- Bring to the Georgetown G. Mello transfer station at 203 E. Main Street, Rt. 133. Open daily, check mellodisposal.com for times. Fees apply.

Household Hazardous Waste

- Bring to the Topsfield annual drop off event typically held in the Fall months. Check topsfield-ma.gov for dates/times.

Electronics Recycling

- Bring to the Masconomet Music Parents annual fundraising event held twice a year. Check topsfield-ma.gov for dates/times.

Other

- Visit "Beyond the Bin" at recyclesmartma.org to find a collection bin, donation option or recycler near you for the following items:
 - Textiles (3 donation bins in Masconomet School lot)
 - Mattresses
 - Any other item you are unsure about
